cPanel and WHM 11 New Features

cPanel and WHM version 11 offers many new features to enhance both the domain and server owner experiences. Key new features are listed below:

Security Enhancements

cPanel and WHM 11 brings with it many security enhancements. While much of the underlying code has been rewritten with an emphasis on security, some new security features have been added for domain and server owners to take advantage of:

Substantial Back end Changes

Many changes have been made to the cPanel and WHM backend to improve security, increase speed, and add new features and flexibility.

cPHulk Brute Force Protection

cPHulk stops brute force password attacks in their tracks. With configurable options for locking out accounts, and an invisible lockout mode, you'll be able to stop brute force password attacks while gaining valuable information about the attacker.

Host Access Control

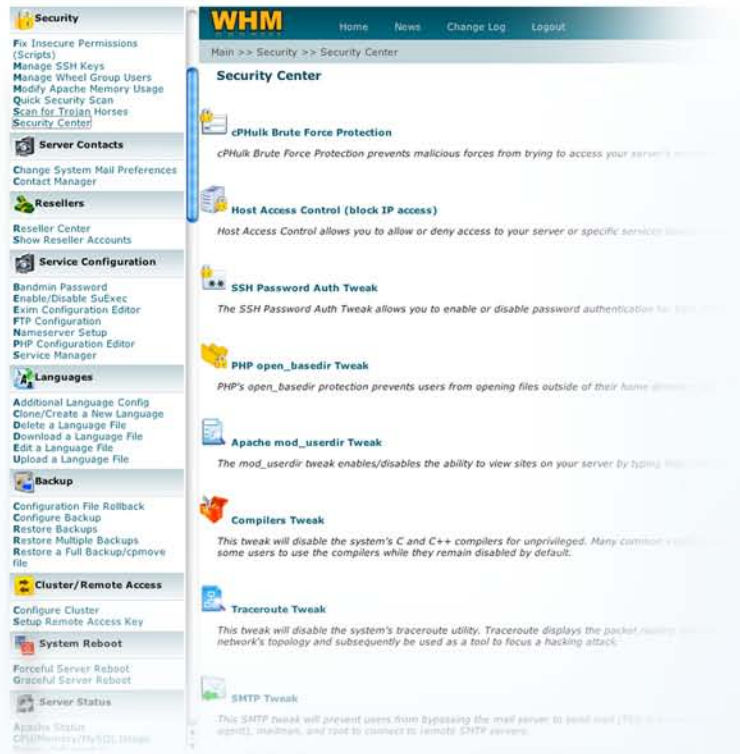
Host Access Control allows the server owner to block traffic from specific IP addresses to specific services like SSH or FTP.

Public Key Authentication

To enhance server security, public key authentication has been built into many of the different areas managed by cPanel and WHM.

Native SSL Interface Access

SSL authentication has been moved from stunnel into the cpsrvd layer to provide better security and logging capabilities for secure traffic.

New Features

Along with the many underlying code changes and enhanced usability and design, new features have been integrated into cPanel and WHM for more control over your hosting experience.

»» Apache 2.x Support

Support for Apache 2.0 and 2.2 have been added along with utilities for easy switches from 1.x to 2.x

»» Web Disks

Web Disks allow cPanel interface users to mount their hosting account as a network drive. This means that they can drag and drop files to their hosting account to update their site. FTP or other publishing programs are no longer needed to modify their site.

»» New and Improved File Manager

The new File Manager is the best in the business. Users will feel at home in the interface with right-clicks, drag and drop, and double click navigation. Updating site files on the web has never been so easy!



»» Module Installers

cPanel and WHM users will now be able to install Perl Modules, RubyGems, PHP PEARs, and PHP PECLs (WHM only) with ease. Just type in the name of the module, or use the search feature for a simple install that allows you to spend more time programming.

»» Addon and Sub Domain Flexibility Increased

While previous versions required Addon and Sub Domains to be placed in specific locations, you can now place these domains anywhere within your account's disk space.

»» Simple Branding Editor and Theme Switching (reseller feature)

cPanel Resellers can now brand their clients' interfaces with this simple to use editor. Fast theme switching allows resellers to easily preview the changes.

»» Fast Account Switching (reseller feature)

»» Email User Filters

Email users can now add account specific filters to route their email. This new, easy to use interface provides all the flexibility and usability of a desktop mail client's filtering system.

»» Better OS Integration

Users can configure email accounts for Outlook, Outlook Express, and Mail.app by double-clicking an installation shortcut. Users can also configure their WebDisk on Mac, Windows, or Linux with a simple installer.

To compliment all the great new features and changes to cPanel and WHM, a new cPanel theme, X3, will be released to integrate with cPanel II.

Usability Enhancements

To make cPanel II even easier to use for domain owners, our design team has updated almost the entire interface to enhance usability and flexibility:

»» Getting Started Wizard

A new Getting Started Wizard helps new users learn about their hosting account and their cPanel interface. The wizard runs quicker and answers their questions for them.

»» Reorganizable Feature Boxes

Users can now adjust the position of the new main page feature boxes to move their most used features to the top for easy access. Feature boxes can be collapsed and expanded to put only necessary content in view.

»» Sortability

cPanel II takes advantage of new flexibility built into the cPanel software to allow sorting for all types of lists within the interface. Whether you're looking to find an email account by name, or a subdomain by its location within your account, the new sorting options allow for quick retrieval of useful information to make your hosting experience even better.

»» Integrated On Page Help

With so many features and concepts to keep track of, administrating a web site can be a daunting task. To ease the stress and provide added guidance, integrated help has been added to cPanel II.
